1. Focus and Scope

2. Types of articles

Original research articles, reviews, brief reports, policy forum, news, case reports, case series, systematic reviews, meta analysis, letters, products and services reviews, book reviews, and expert opinion articles can be published in this journal.

3. Editorial policies

Ethics: Sci Journo requires that authors of reports of investigations in humans or animals indicate that those studies were formally approved by a relevant ethics committee or review board.

Conflict of Interest: All authors are required to disclose any actual or potential conflict of interest including financial interests or relationships with other people or organizations that might raise questions of bias in the work reported. If no conflict of interest exists for each author, please state "There is no conflict of interest to disclose".

Submission Declaration: When a manuscript is considered for submission to Sci Journo the authors should confirm that 1) no part of this manuscript is currently under consideration for publication elsewhere; 2) this manuscript does not contain the same information in whole or in part as manuscripts that have been published, accepted, or are under review elsewhere, except in the form of an abstract, a letter to the editor, or part of a



published lecture or academic thesis; 3) authorization for publication has been obtained from the authors' employer or institution; and 4) all contributing authors have agreed to submit this manuscript.

Cover Letter: The manuscript must be accompanied by a cover letter signed by the corresponding author on behalf of all authors. The letter should indicate the basic findings of the work and their significance. The letter should also include a statement affirming that all authors concur with the submission and that the material submitted for publication has not been published previously or is not under consideration for publication elsewhere.

3. Manuscript Preparation

Manuscripts should be written in clear, grammatically correct English and submitted as a Microsoft Word file in a single-column format. Manuscripts must be paginated and typed in 12-point Times New Roman font with single spacing. Figures and tables can also be submitted separately. Abbreviations should be used as little as possible and should be explained at first mention unless the term is a well-known abbreviation (e.g. DNA). Single words should not be abbreviated.

Manuscripts can be divided into Title, Affiliations, Corresponding authors address and contact numbers with email, Keywords, Abstract, Introduction, Materials and methods, Results and discussion, References, Acknowledgements, etc.

4. Referencing

5. Manuscript Submission Checklist

Please check the following items and submit both this list and your manuscript.

Cover letter

Cover letter has been signed by the corresponding author on behalf of all authors.

Conflict of interest

State conflict of interest if any

Authors' names

All authors' full names are indicated (with the first name before the family name).



Abbreviated names in the style used in PubMed are required on the title page.

The postal code/number is indicated (if there is one).

Different affiliations are indicated with Arabic numerals 1, 2, 3....

Corresponding author

The corresponding author's e-mail address is indicated on the title page.

List of figures and tables

Image files

Table files

Article processing charges

Online certificate of publication is issued once article is accepted for publication.

6. Submission Preparation Checklist

As part of the submission process, authors are required to check off their submission's compliance with all of the following items, and submissions may be returned to authors that do not adhere to these guidelines.

1. The submission has not been previously published, nor is it before another journal for consideration (or an explanation has been provided in Comments to the Editor).
2. The submission file is in OpenOffice, Microsoft Word, RTF, or WordPerfect document file format.
3. Where available, URLs for the references have been provided.
4. The text is single-spaced; uses a 12-point font; employs italics, rather than underlining (except with URL addresses); and all illustrations, figures, and tables are placed within the text at the appropriate points, rather than at the end.
5. The text adheres to the stylistic and bibliographic requirements outlined in the Author Guidelines,
6. If submitting to a peer-reviewed section of the journal, the instructions in Ensuring a Blind Review have been followed.

7. Privacy Statement

The names and email addresses entered in this journal site will be used exclusively for the stated purposes of this journal and will not be made available for any other purpose or to any other party.
